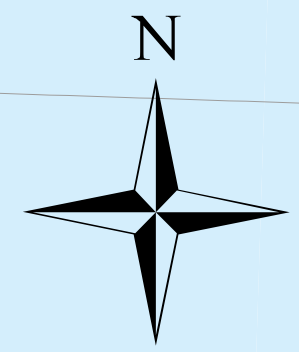
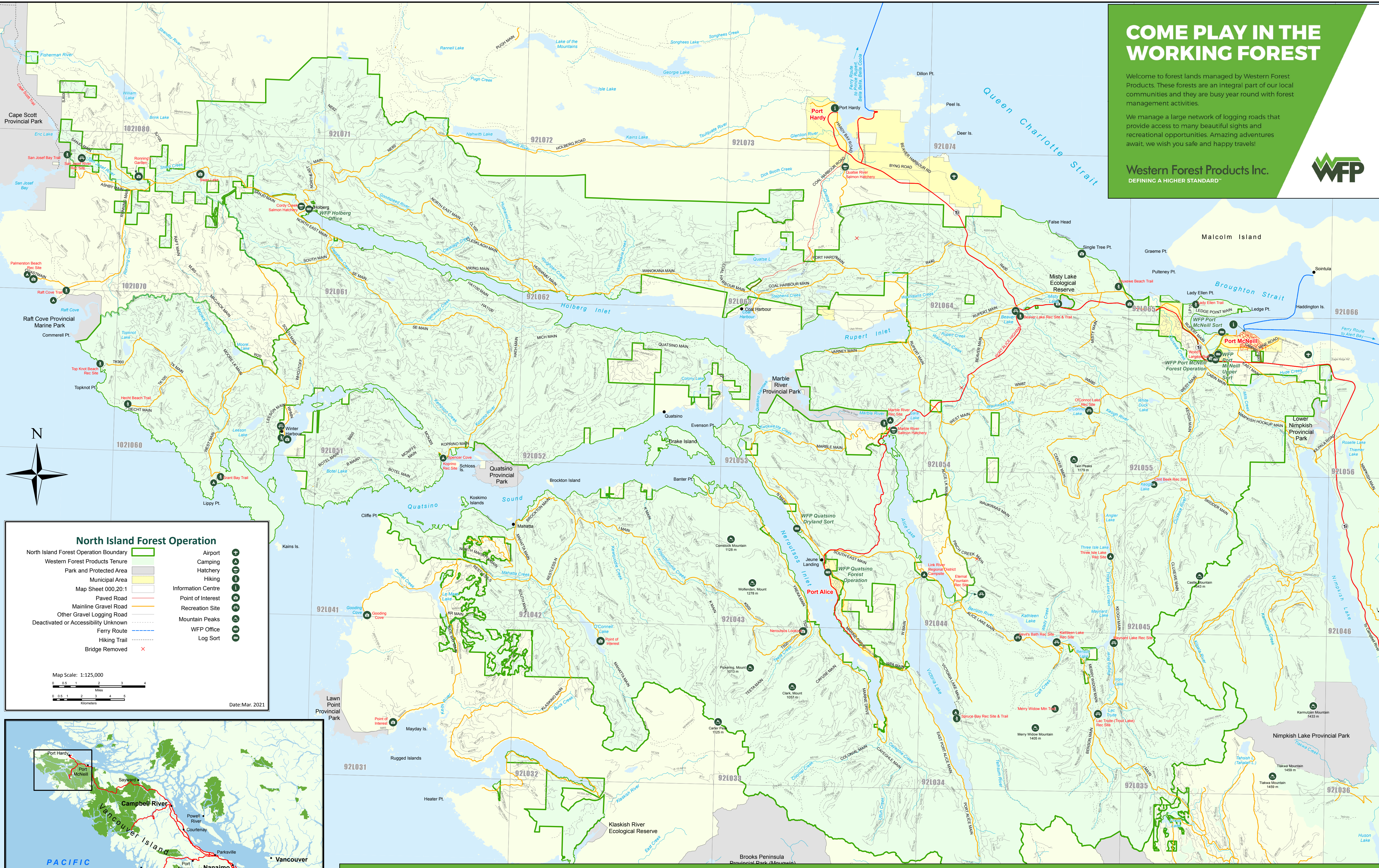

TIPS FOR BACKROAD TRAVEL

- Expect to be sharing these roads with heavy equipment and logging trucks.
 - » Stay calm and pull over immediately so logging trucks can pass.
 - » Back up if necessary. Logging trucks cannot pull-over.
 - » Wait patiently for the dust to settle before continuing at safe speeds.
- Drive with headlights on.
- Expect to navigate independently, there may be no directional signs.
- Expect rough surfaces, potholes, and in the case of deactivated roads, cross ditches.
- Cell phone service is unavailable outside of main communities.
- Be prepared – supplies should include food and water, a first aid kit, warm clothes, a full tank of fuel and a spare tire.
- Let someone know where you are heading and when you expect to return.
